### APPLICATION FOR SCHOLARSHIP

---

**Background:**

This scholarship has been established through the Monmouth County Chapter of the United States Lifesaving Association to award a certified ocean lifeguard with tuition assistance. One \$500 scholarship will be available on a periodic basis for a student pursuing a baccalaureate degree at an accredited post-secondary institution.

**Eligibility:**

One \$500 scholarship is available periodically to a Monmouth County lifeguard who is a full-time, certified member of an agency recognized by the State of New Jersey and the Monmouth County Chapter of the United States Lifesaving Association. The lifeguard must be a Class B or A Lifeguard as defined by the USLA and generally describes a lifeguard with 2 to 4 or more seasons of lifeguard experience and more than 250 hours of lifeguard experience.

**Criteria:**

- A GPA of 2.75 or above
- Financial need
- Written documentation of student status from the post-secondary institution or
- Documentation of acceptance at an accredited post-secondary institution

**Application:**

- Complete the attached application form
- Applicants must supply a letter of recommendation from a school official, teacher/professor, or counselor
- Applicants must provide a brief statement describing educational goals
- Write an essay of approximately 500 words on “Why I Have Chosen Ocean Lifeguarding as Summer Employment”
- Provide written verification of a GPA of 2.75 or above
- Provide written verification of acceptance or attendance at an accredited post-secondary institution
